





INTRODUCTION



- System and Regulatory fees will be auto-calculated in SEDAR+
- Almost all fee calculations in SEDAR+ are working correctly
- There are a few instances where SEDAR+ will <u>undercharge</u> or <u>overcharge</u> fees at go-live
- The purpose of this presentation is to inform you about the miscalculations so you are not surprised and can implement the necessary workarounds to avoid being overcharged





SEDAR+ FEE CALCULATION ERRORS WORKAROUND GUIDE

- This guide has been created to identify the fee calculation errors and summarize any action required to be taken by the filer, for each error

TYPES OF FEE ERRORS

Two main types of fee errors in SEDAR+

- I. When certain filings are made against a migrated filing or amend a filing that was originally filed outside SEDAR+
 - these errors are temporary and will eventually be eliminated as amendments stop being made against non-SEDAR+ initiated filings
- 2. In certain rare circumstances, when a new filing is made on SEDAR+ -
 - These errors will continue until calculations are updated in a future release





FEE EXCEPTION CODE

- SEDAR+ requires payment of the calculated fee in order to file unless a filer enters a fee
 exception code at the time of filing
- The fee exception code zero's out the calculated system or regulatory fee
- A separate fee exception code is required
 - for each jurisdiction's regulatory fee
 - for a system fee
- After using a fee exception code to file with no fee, the recipient agency will create the correct outstanding fee in SEDAR+ and request the filer to return and pay the outstanding fee





USING A FEE EXCEPTION CODE

- Before submitting a filing, SEDAR+ provides a 'Fee attributes' page where you will enter the code
- Codes may be entered for multiple jurisdictions, if required
- The fee attribute information is still required to be entered when using a fee exception code





TYPES OF WORKAROUNDS WHEN SYSTEM OVERCHARGES

To workaround being <u>overcharged</u> by the system:

- I. Obtain fee exception code to zero out fee
- 2. Enter 0 (zero) in fee attributes to zero out fee (applies only to "Certificate/ notice(s) re: proceeds of distribution" filings)

The recipient agency will create the correct outstanding fee in SEDAR+ and request the filer to return and pay the outstanding fee, where applicable.






WORKAROUND WHEN SYSTEM UNDERCHARGES

When the system undercharges:

I. A filer should pay the fee calculated by the system and submit the filing

The recipient agency or CSA Service Desk will create an outstanding fee for the undercharged amount and request the filer to return to SEDAR+ and pay the outstanding fee.





FEE CALCULATION ERROR DETAILS



TYPE I FEE CALCULATION ERRORS

- Apply when certain filings are made against migrated filings or that amend filings made outside SEDAR+
- These errors are temporary and will eventually be eliminated as amendments stop being made against non-SEDAR+ initiated filings





TYPE I FEE ERRORS: FILINGS MADE AGAINST MIGRATED FILINGS OR THAT AMEND FILINGS MADE OUTSIDE SEDAR+

Fee Issue ID	Filing Type	Applicable Jurisdiction	Calculation issue
1-1	Shelf prospectus: the first few prospectus supplements filed against a prospectus filing that was originally filed on SEDAR	QC	Overcharging
1-2	Prospectus: Certificate / notice(s)re proceeds of distribution, for a prospectus filing that was originally filed on SEDAR Demo provided later	AB, BC, QC, SK	Overcharging
1-3	Take-over bid / Formal issuer bid: Notice of Change or Variation for filings originally filed on SEDAR	AB, NB, NS, NU, QC	Undercharging





TYPE I FEE ERRORS: FILINGS MADE AGAINST MIGRATED FILINGS OR THAT AMEND FILINGS MADE OUTSIDE SEDAR+

Fee Issue ID	Filing Type	Applicable Jurisdiction	Calculation issue
I-4	Report of Exempt Distribution that amends a filing originally filed in paper format (i.e. outside of SEDAR, the BCSC e-services or OSC e-portal).	Impacts all jurisdictions except ON, BC and PE	Overcharging
1-5	Report of exempt distribution that amends a filing originally filed in SEDAR or on the OSC e-portal and the amendment results in additional fees owing	Impacts all jurisdictions except BC and PE	Undercharging





TYPE 2 FEE CALCULATION ERRORS

- Apply when a new filing is made on SEDAR+, in certain rare circumstances
- These errors will continue until calculations are updated in a future release





TYPE 2 FEE ERRORS: NEW FILINGS MADE ON SEDAR+

Fee Issue ID	Filing Type	Applicable Jurisdiction	Calculation issue
2-1	Certain applications, pre-filings and waiver applications made for more than one profile	ON	Undercharging
2-2	Prospectus pre-files under CSA SN 43-310	AB	Overcharging
2-3	Pre-filings related to a prospectus under NP 11-202	AB, BC, MB, NB, NS, ON, QC, SK	Undercharging
2-4	Prospectus filings that have a related pre-filing	AB	Overcharging





TYPE 2 FEE ERRORS: NEW FILINGS MADE ON SEDAR+

Fee Issue ID	Filing Type	Applicable Jurisdiction	Calculation issue
2-5	Amended and restated prospectus filings by a subset of all funds in the group	Impacts all jurisdictions except ON and BC	Overcharging
2-6	Report of Exempt Distribution filed late, and the late period is longer than 20 days and extends beyond March 31.	NB	Undercharging
2-7	Prospectus: Combination subtypes – When there is more than one instance of using the new subtypes to add a fund or jurisdiction to the filing	Impacts all jurisdictions except ON	Overcharging

WORKAROUND DETAILS



ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN BY FILERS

Overcharging Workaround	Fee Issue ID
I. Obtain fee exception code(s) to zero out fee	
Contact the CSA Service desk for codes if multiple jurisdictions involved	I-4, 2-5, 2-7
Contact the recipient agency if only one jurisdiction is involved	1-1, 2-2
Recipient agency will contact the filer if need for code is anticipated	2-4
2. Enter 0 (zero) in fee attributes to zero out the fee	1-2

The recipient agency will create the correct outstanding fee in SEDAR+ and request the filer to return and pay the outstanding fee, where applicable.






ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN BY FILERS

Undercharging Workaround	Fee Issue ID
I. Filer should pay the fee calculated by the system and submit the filing	1-3, 1-5, 2-1, 2-3, 2-6

The recipient agency will create an outstanding fee in SEDAR+ for the undercharged amount and request the filer to return and pay the outstanding fee.





DEMONSTRATION



- In this demonstration, a long form prospectus has already been filed
- Previously, BC and Saskatchewan were added to the prospectus filing using one of the combination subtypes
- Now the filer would like to add Manitoba to the filing
- We know from the fee calculation errors guide that SEDAR+ will not calculate the filings fees correctly, so the filer will need to use the following workaround






- Before creating the submission to add the new jurisdiction, the filer will need to contact the CSA Service Desk to request fee exception codes
- We have created templates to assist filers in requesting these fee exception codes


 The CSA Service Desk will provide the requested fee exception codes to the filer







- These fee exception codes can be entered, at the time of filing, on the 'fee attributes' page
- After the submission has been submitted, each applicable recipient agency will create an outstanding fee for any amount owing in their jurisdiction

• When filing a Certificate / notice(s)re proceeds of distribution in SEDAR+ against a prospectus filing that originated in SEDAR, the following workaround will need to be followed:

 On the 'fee attributes' page, the filer will need to enter '0' (zero) in the 'net proceeds' or 'gross proceeds' field for each issuer

- This will prevent SEDAR+ from charging a fee for this submission
- Each applicable recipient agency will create an outstanding fee for any amount owing in their jurisdiction
- It is important to note that in SEDAR+, the Certificate / notice(s)re proceeds of distribution will need to be filed in the same filing as the prospectus to which it pertains


